The TEACUP Yorkie if bred correctly and reared and raised by its owner correctly, can live every bit as long a life as the normal standard yorkie – up to 16 years of age. We have a Specialist Veterinary Physicians opinion on this as well – he agrees 100% with MIJOY. YOU do however have to have the lifestyle and the knowledge, to cope with this sized baby. WE DO NOT BREED WITH OUR TEACUP DOGS

The TEACUP if bred correctly is NOT a sickly dog.

Pups/dogs that suffer with repeated bouts of Hypoglycemia in all probability have an underlying health problem – consult your vet.

NO pup or dogs blood sugar needs to be stabilized by using GLUCOSE – If Glucose is used or needed – in all probability - there is an underlying health problem – consult your vet.
